YOUR WEEKLY CHECKLIST

Backyard water-holding containers make perfect mozzie breeding habitats because mozzies need still and stagnant water to lay their eggs. The mozzie breeding cycle only takes 8-10 days. Follow the weekly checklist below to reduce mozzies around your home.

CHECKLIST

EMPTY AND...

STORE IN A DRY PLACE OR DISPOSE

- Buckets
- Kids toys
- Watering cans
- Plastic containers
- Tarpaulins
- Tyres
- Wading pools

COMPOST

- Fallen palm fronds

CLEAN (OR WIPE OUT) AND REFILL

- Pet bowls
- Bird baths
- Stock troughs

CLEAN

- Trailers
- Boats
- Gutters
- Drains



WIPE DRY

- Pot plant trays. You can also fill these with sand to absorb excess water.

QUICK FLUSH WITH A HOSE

- Small water features and ornamental fountains
- Water-holding plants like bromeliads
